Grandparenting Policy, Bye Law 1
(for Child Art Psychotherapists who completed the
Higher Diploma in Visual Psychotherapy/Child Art Psychotherapy or MSc in Child Art
Psychotherapy prior to the Inclusion of Group Therapy Hours within the Training)

Child Art Psychotherapists applying for Accreditation under the above named Grandparenting Policy may avail of the reduced rate of Personal Therapy Hours required, only up until this Policy is due to be revised annually at the ACAP AGM when these hours will be subject to change. This Bye Law only applies to graduates of the HDip in Visual Psychotherapy/Child Art Psychotherapy or MSc in Child Art Psychotherapy prior to the inclusion of 90 hours of Group Therapy within the training in 2009.

Child Art Psychotherapists who qualify for this reduction of hours are still required to provide evidence of the completion of a minimum of 160 personal therapy hours. All other requirements remain the same as for other applicants, as laid out in the ACAP Grandparenting Policy of March 2025.
