**(for Child Art Psychotherapists who completed the**  
**Higher Diploma in Visual Psychotherapy/Child Art Psychotherapy or MSc in Child Art**  
**Psychotherapy prior to the availability of the Post Masters in Child Art Psychotherapy in**  
**2015)**

**May 2021**

Child Art Psychotherapists who qualified from the HDip/MSc prior to September 2021, who do not yet hold an additional MSc/MA in Psychotherapy or the Post Masters in Child Art Psychotherapy, may apply for pre-accredited membership with ACAP on the basis that they intend to complete either the Post Masters in Child Art Psychotherapy or an additional MSc/MA in an ICP, UKCP and EAP recognised psychotherapeutic training prior to their application for full accreditation.

Child Art Psychotherapists to whom this Bye Law applies must submit evidence of their Supervised Practice Hours, Supervision Hours (including a Supervisor's Report Form) and Personal Therapy Hours, as part of their application for pre-accredited membership. An application for full accreditation upon successful completion of the second two year training period must be submitted by September 2031.

This Bye Law will be revised annually.
